S.O.S. took the first step in preserving the quality of our water by protecting the Barton Creek Watershed from rampant development.

Now, the BCCP bond proposal (The Balcones Canyonlands Conservation Plan, Proposition No. 1) is taking the second step by protecting the Bull Creek and Lake Austin Watersheds.

Proposition No. 1 will allow us to purchase 85-90% of the undeveloped land in the Bull Creek Watershed and 60% of the undeveloped land between Loop 360 and Lake Travis.

The BCCP bonds will not only help us preserve the quality of our water, but will allow us to maintain 117 sq. miles of parks, open space, and nature preserves in the Travis County Hill Country for generations to come.
