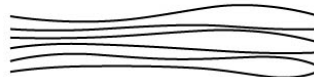

I worked on the creation of the 1986 Comprehensive Watersheds Ordinance and managed its implementation throughout the city. I worked on the creation of the Barton Creek Planned Unit Development (PUD) and testified at the beginning of the hearing to provide an overview of the environmental issues affecting the Barton Creek Watershed. At the hearing I predicted that the Barton Springs Pool could be closed more often. I wrote the BCCP which protected endangered species in the Barton Creek Watershed and over the years as Director of various city environmental departments worked to protect Barton Springs from pollution.
