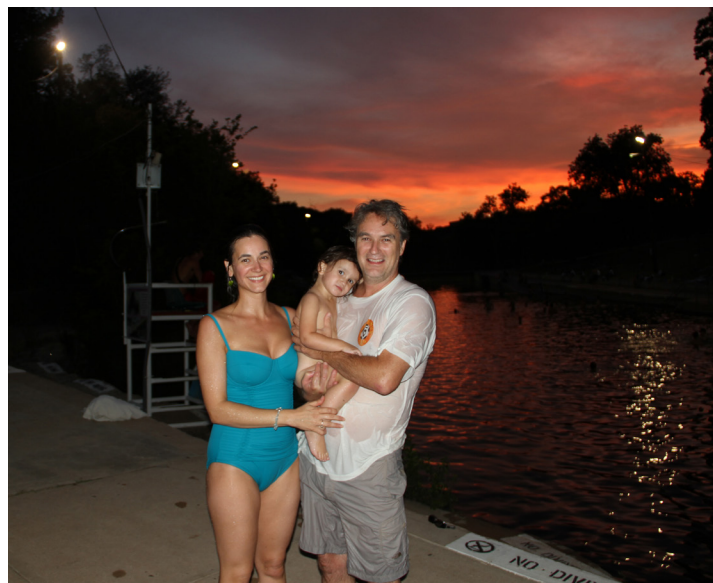
Barton Springs is never saved, you have to save it everyday.”
